

1. Study Sixth edition Chapter 4, Section 4.2.

2. Do Exercise 4.5.

Type your solutions in a text editor or word processor app and save it in a `.pdf` file. You cannot simply change the extension of your file name from `.docx`, or `.rtf`, or `.txt` to `.pdf`. You must *export* your document as a `.pdf` file.

Submit your `.pdf` file as an attachment in Canvas under Assignment 7a.

3. Do Problem 4.10(b).

Download the Pepp IDE app, and write your program in the ISA3 Pep/10 Bare Metal mode.

Name your file `xxprob0410.papo` (all lowercase) where `xx` is your assigned two-digit number. For example, if your two-digit number is 99 you would name it `99prob0410.papo`. Note that the app will automatically append the file extension `.papo`.

Hand in your file as an attachment in Canvas under Assignment 7b.
